

This is to help ensure we maintain a safe and caring school environment for our students.

- The main entrance doors and those in the grade 7/8 wing will be unlocked from 8:30 8:53 AM.
 For this reason, students are asked to please begin arriving at school starting at 8:30am, not earlier.
- During class time and at the 5 minute breaks all doors will remain locked. Any students in grades 7-12 who arrive late in the morning or after the lunch break will have to ring the doorbell at the main entrance to and office staff will let them in.
- The main entrance doors will be unlocked from 12:16 1:01 PM. The grade 7/8 entrance will remain locked, so students in grades 7&8 who leave the school at lunch will need to re-enter through the main entrance.
- Supervision is provided at the main door in the morning, at lunch break, and afterschool

When possible, any visitors coming to the school when the doors are locked are asked to call the school office at (780) 836-3397 before ringing the doorbell. Cameras and new doorbells will be installed soon. Currently, the doorbell rings throughout the entire school which can be disruptive to students' learning.
