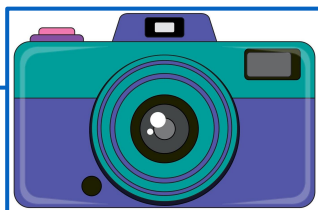

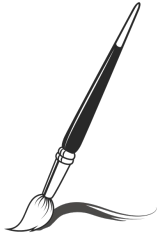

# OCTOBER SCHOOL EVENTS



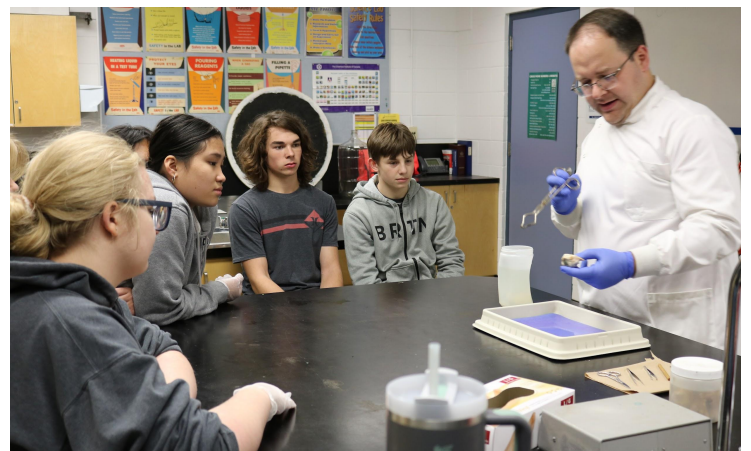
